

## The L-RD'S Prayer Is Truly The Disciple's Prayer

Based on the Model of the L-RD's Prayer by Dr. Larry Lea, "Could You Not Tarry For One Hour" – Compiled by Messianic Rabbi Ed Rothman

**Matthew 6:5-9** – After this manner therefore pray: **Our Father** who art in Heaven, hallowed be Your name (May your name be sanctified). Let your light so shine, glorify your Father in Heaven.

Remember Calvary, picture Y'shua on the cross, enabling you to speak directly to G-d and call Him your Abba, your Daddy, your Father in Heaven, because of what the suffering, the shed blood, and the death of Y'shua has accomplished for us.

A. Hallow (make holy) the covenantal redemptive names of G-d, which correspond to the benefits of the New Covenant ratified for us by Y'shua's shed blood.

1. **Adonai Tsidkaynu** – The L-RD Is Our Righteousness – Redemption from Sin unto Salvation
  - Jer. 23:6b – This is the name whereby He shall be called, The L-RD our Righteousness.
  - 1 Cor. 1:30 – But of G-d are you in Messiah Y'shua, whom G-d has made unto us Wisdom, righteousness, sanctification and redemption.
  - 2 Cor. 5:21 – For G-d has made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of G-d in Him.
2. **Adonai M'Kaddeshkem** – The L-RD Who Sanctifies – Redemption from Separation
  - Exo. 31:13c – That you may know that I am the L-RD who sanctifies you.
  - 1 Cor. 6:9-11 & 19-20 – You're bought w/ a price, you're the Temple of the Holy Spirit
  - 1 Thes. 5:23 – And the very G-d of peace sanctify you wholly, spirit, soul and body.
3. **Adonai Shammah** – The L-RD Is There – Redemption for our Spirit
  - Ezek. 48:35b – And the name of the city from that day shall be, The L-RD is there.
  - Matt. 28:20b – Lo, I AM with you always, even unto the end of the world.
  - Heb. 13:5b – I will never leave you or forsake you.
4. **Adonai Shalom** – The L-RD Is Our Peace – Redemption for our Soul
  - Judges 6:24a – Gideon built an altar there unto the L-RD and called it, The L-RD is peace.
  - Isaiah 53:5b – The chastisement of our peace was upon Him.
  - Eph. 2:14a – He is our peace, taking away the division, Jews & Gentiles now one in Him.
  - Colossians 1:20a – And having made peace by the blood of His cross.
  - John 16:33 – These words have I spoken that in Me you might have peace.
5. **Adonai Rohfekha** – The L-RD Is Our Healer – Redemption for our Bodies
  - Exo. 15:26 – Harken diligently to My voice, for I AM the L-RD that heals you.
  - Isa. 53:4a & 5b – Surely He has borne our sicknesses and carried our diseases, and with His stripes we are healed.
  - Acts 10:38 – How G-d anointed Y'shua of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power; who went about doing good & healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for G-d was with Him.
6. **Adonia Yireh** – The L-RD Provides – Redemption for our Supernatural Provision
  - Gen. 22:14 – And Abraham called the name of that place Adonai-Yireh: as it is said to this day, in the mount of the L-RD it shall be seen.
  - 2 Chron. 16:9a – For the eyes of the L-RD run to and for throughout the whole earth to show Himself strong in behalf of those whose heart is perfect toward Him.
  - Psalm 37:3-4 – Delight thyself in the L-RD and He shall give you the desires of your heart.
7. **Adonai Nissi** – The L-RD Is Our Banner – Redemption (Victory) for the Battles of Life
  - Exo. 17:14-16 – And Moses built an altar & named it Adonai Nissi (The L-RD our victory).
  - 1 Chron. 29:11-13 – Thine O L-RD is the greatness, the power, the glory & the victory.
  - 2 Cor. 2:14a – Now thanks be to G-d who always causes us to triumph in Messiah.
8. **Adonai Rohi** – The L-RD Is My Shepherd – Redemption from Facing Life's Challenges Alone
  - Psa. 23:1 – The L-RD is my Shepherd; I shall not want.
  - Jer. 3:15 – And I will give you shepherds according to my heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.
  - 1 Pet. 2:25 – You have returned to the Shepherd & Bishop of your souls.

- B. Your Kingdom come. Your will be done in earth, as it is in Heaven.
1. The Kingdom of G-d is the dominion / rulership of G-d in / over our lives. Pastor Bill Johnson of Bethel Church, in Redding, CA, has said, "When we pray for His Kingdom to come, we are asking G-d to superimpose the rules, order, and benefits of His world (Heaven) over this one (earth) until this one looks like His."
    - a. Mat. 3:2 – Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.
    - b. Mat. 4:16-17 – Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand . . .
    - c. Mat. 4:23 – preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom
    - d. Mat. 5:3 & 10 – for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven
    - e. Mat. 6:33 – Seek ye first the kingdom of G-d and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.
    - f. Luke 17:21 – The Kingdom of G-d is within you.
  2. When we seek first the Kingdom of G-d it should have an impact on our priorities and the major focus of our life. We are ambassadors of the Kingdom of G-d and as such, we should be representing and advancing the cause of His Kingdom everyday in every way.
    - a. Ourselves – Romans 12:1-2 – Our bodies a living sacrifice, transform our mind.
    - b. Our Family – Proverbs 22:6 – Train up a child in the way he should go and when he is old he will not depart from it. (Train – Heb. Chanack = A protective fence providing direction for the activities of life) (way) – Heb. Derek = A door or pathway, opened and covered by the Head persons (Father & Mother) & Isa. 54:13 – all thy children shall be taught of the L-RD and great shall be the peace of they children.
    - c. Our Congregation – Heb. 10:24-25 – Don't forsake assembly, provoke to good work
      - i. The Leadership, (ii.) Their Faithfulness, (iii.) The Harvest
    - d. Our Nation – Pro. 14:34 – Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people. & 1 Tim. 2:1-4 – 1<sup>st</sup> prayer must be made for all that are in authority.
      - i. City / County – Mayor, City Council, Fire & Police Departments, County Commissioners
      - ii. State – Governor, Lt. Governor, Cabinet, Legislature & State Supreme Court
      - iii. Nation – President, Vice-President, Cabinet, Congress & Supreme Court
    - e. Israel
      - i. Psalm 122:6-9 – Pray for the peace of Jerusalem, prosperity in her palaces.
      - ii. Isa. 62: 1-7 – For Zion's sake be not silent until she is a praise in the earth.
      - iii. Romans 11:11,12 & 15 - Salvation to Gentiles to provoke Jews to jealousy.
- C. Give us this day our daily bread.
1. Genesis 3:17-19 – The ground is cursed w/ thorns, we eat bread by the sweat of our brow.
    - a. Mat. 27:27-30 – Crown of thorns on Y'shua redeemed us from the curse upon the ground.
  2. Gen. 14:18 – Melchizedek, King of Salem [later called Jerusalem], brought out bread and wine [for their nourishment]; he was the priest of El Elyon (G-d Most High).
    - a. Gen. 18:1-8 – Abraham hosted G-d & 2 angels and fed them butter, milk & a tender calf.
    - b. Gen. 19:3 – [Lot] entreated and them greatly until they (the angels) yielded, and entered his house. And Lot made them dinner (with drinking) and had made unleavened bread, which he baked: and they ate.
    - c. Gen. 25:29-34 – Jacob fed starving Esau and traded it for the birthright of the firstborn.
  3. Ruth 1:6 – For (Naomi) had heard how the L-RD had visited his people in giving them bread.
  4. Mat. 4:1-4 – Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from G-d.
    - a. Deut. 8:1-20 – G-d gives the power to get wealth, do not forget this when your prosper.
  5. Psalm 132:13-16 – G-d will abundantly bless Zion's provision, satisfy her poor w/ bread.
  6. Phil. 4:19 – My G-d shall supply all your need > Prov. 30:8-9 – Give me neither riches / poverty

7. 3 John 2 – Beloved I pray that you may **prosper in every way** and [that your body] may keep well [be kept in health], even as your soul keeps well and prospers (Greek – Yoo-od-o-oh -help on the road, succeed in reaching your destination, in business affairs, a prosperous journey).
- D. And forgive us our debts, as we (also have) forgiven our debtors.
1. Matthew 18:10-35 – Forgive 70 X 7 or Heavenly Father will not forgive your trespasses.
  2. Luke 11:4 – And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive everyone that is indebted to us (has offended us or done us wrong).
    - a. Mark 11:23-26 – When you stand praying, forgive
    - b. Mark 12:30-31 – The greatest commandment
    - c. 1 John 4:7-11 – Let's love one another. He that loveth not, knoweth not G-d, for G-d is love.
  3. Luke 6:27-42 - Love your enemies, bless those who curse you & pray for those who abuse you.
- E. And lead us not into temptation . . .
1. Deuteronomy 8:2 – “And thou shalt remember all the way which the L-RD thy G-d led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.
  2. James 1:12-17 – Blessed is the one who endures temptation, they'll receive the crown of life.
  3. Genesis 3:1-7 – “Has G-d said?” (1) tree, good food, (2) pleasant to eyes, (3) makes one wise
    - a. 1 John 2:15-17 – In the world (1) lust of the flesh, (2) lust of the eyes, (3) the pride of life.
    - b. Luke 4:1-14 – The Spirit led Y'shua into the wilderness to be tempted by the adversary. He was tempted to turn the (1) stones into bread, (2) kingdoms of world, (3) rescued by angels before all the priests & worshippers in the Temple.
      - i. Psalm 19:13 – “Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright and I shall be innocent of the great transgression. “
      - ii. Psalm 119:133 – “Order my steps in Thy Word: and let not any iniquity have dominion over me.”
  4. 1 Corinthians 10:13 – “there hath no temptation taken thee but such as is common to man: but G-d is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able: but will with the temptation also make a way of escape, that ye may be able to bear it.”
  5. Ephesians 6:10-18 – Cover your life with the 7 pieces of the whole Armor of G-d (each piece is in reality is either the Word of G-d or based on the Word of G-d).
    - a. Loins girt with truth – Thy Word is Truth – John 17:17
    - b. The breastplate of Righteousness – Skillful in the Word of Righteousness - Hebrews 5:13
    - c. Feet shod w/ Gospel of Peace – Beautiful feet bring Gospel of Peace – Romans 10:15
    - d. The Shield of Faith – Word of Faith which we preach – Romans 10:8
    - e. The Helmet of Salvation – To you is the Word of this Salvation sent – Acts 13:26
    - f. The Sword of the Spirit – which is the Word of G-d – Ephesians 6:17
    - g. Praying always with all Prayer – to make known the mystery of the Gospel – Eph. 6:18-19
      - i. Mat. 26:41 – “Watch and pray that you enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.”
  6. Psalm 91 – Pray daily as a hedge of protection over you & your loved ones.
  7. James 1:2-4 – Count it all joy when you encounter diverse temptations
    - a. 1 Peter 4:12-14 – Rejoice when reproached for Messiah, G-d's spirit & glory rest upon you.
- F. but deliver us from evil. – This is a revelation that is unique to faith in Y'shua & the New Covenant.
- a. Mat. 28:18 – 19 – “All authority has been given unto me in heaven & in earth, go therefore.”
  - b. Luke 10:17-20 – Devils are subject to us as we tread on all authority & power of the Devil.
    - i. Mark 16:17 – “These signs shall follow believers, in My name they shall cast out devils.”

- c. Eph. 1:17-23 – Exceeding greatness of his power to believers over all principality & power.
  - i. Eph. 6:16 – Take the shield of faith & quenching all the fiery darts of the wicked one.
- d. Phil. 2:10 – At Y’shua’s name, every knee must bow in heaven, earth & beneath the earth.
- e. Col. 1:12-19 – Delivered from the power of darkness, translated into the Kingdom of G-d.
- f. Col. 2:9-12 – We’re complete in Him, who is the head of all principality & power.
- g. Col. 2:15 – Having spoiled principalities & powers, has triumphed over them.
- h. 2 Tim. 1:7 – “For G-d hasn’t given the spirit of fear: but of power, love, and a sound mind.”
- i. 2 Tim. 2:19-26 – That they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil.
- j. Heb. 2:14-15 – Through death He destroyed him who had power over death, the devil.
- k. James 4:6-7 – Submit yourselves to G-d. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- l. 1 Pet. 5:5-9 – Humble yourselves, cast your cares, be sober; the devil seeks to devour.
- m. 1 John 3:8 – The purpose the Son of G-d was manifested, to destroy the works of the devil.
- n. 1 John 4:4 – You have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you.
- o. 1 John 5:4-5 – Whatsoever is born of G-d overcomes the world: faith is the victory.
- p. Jude vs. 8-9 – Michael the archangel disputed with devil, “The L-RD rebuke thee.”
  - i. Zec. 3:1-2 – The L-RD said, “The L-RD rebuke thee, O Satan, the L-RD rebuke thee.”
- q. Rev. 12:7-12 – We overcome the devil by the blood of the Lamb, the word of our testimony, and by not loving our lives unto death.

G. For Thine is the Kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever, Amen.

1. **KINGDOM - Mat. 6:10 – “*Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.*”**  
 We have already prayed for His Kingdom to come, now, in faith we are completing the prayer by declaring that it is both a present reality and a future fullness (the tension between “The Kingdom Now, but Not Yet [in it’s fullness]”)
  - A.** Mat. 6:33 – “But seek ye first the Kingdom of G-d, and all these things will be added unto you.”
  - B.** Luke 12:32 – “Fear not little flock; for it is Your Father’s good pleasure to give you the Kingdom.”
  - C.** Col. 3:12-17 – “And whatever you do, no matter what it is, in word or in deed, do everything in the name of the L-RD Y’shua (Jesus) the Messiah [and in dependence upon His Person], giving praise to G-d the Father through Him.
2. **POWER – Mat. 7:15-23 – *Therefore you will fully know them by their fruits.***
  - A.** Mat. 9:1-8 – “They praised **G-d who had given such power & authority to men.**
  - B.** Mat. 28:18-20 – “**All authority – power of rule – in heaven and on earth has been given unto Me, go therefore . . .**
  - C.** Luke 10:16-20 – “Behold, **I have given you power & authority to tread upon serpents & scorpions and nothing by any means shall harm you.**”
  - D.** Acts 10:38 – “How G-d anointed Y’shua (Jesus) of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power; and He went about doing good & healing ALL that were oppressed by the devil.”
3. **GLORY – 1 Cor. 10:31 – “So then, whether you eat or drink, or **whatever you may do, do all for the honor and glory of G-d.**”**
  - A.** Eph. 1:17-23 – “For I always pray the G-d of our L-RD Y’shua the Messiah, **the Father of Glory, may grant you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him.**
  - B.** Col. 1:27 – “To whom G-d was pleased to make known how great for the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which **is Messiah within you, the hope of realizing the glory.**
  - C.** Exo. 33:13-19 – “And Moses said, **I beseech You, show me Your glory!**”
  - D.** John 17:20-23 – “I have given them the glory and honor which You have given Me, **that they may be one, even as we are one.**”
